1. Livestock entry fee are as follows:

2. Trailers will be parked in designated areas ONLY. No trailers will be parked inside the gates. See General Rules #1.
3. Competition and exhibition will be open to members of Valencia County 4-H Clubs and FFA chapters. Exhibits must represent current projects.
4. Buyer's Appreciation Fee - \$10.00 per Exhibitor Due July 16, 2018.
5. There will be no pen or stall fee.
6. Livestock will be accepted on the grounds as follows: **ALL LIVESTOCK** Wednesday, August 8
7. All animals must remain in the livestock area once they are checked in and remain there until released by the superintendent of that department. The livestock area is defined by the check-in gates up to the quonset hut, the area south of the pig barn and show ring to the south boundary fence, and the area between the quonset hut and rabbit and poultry barn.
8. All animals presented for exhibition shall be free from contagious/infectious diseases and be subject to examination during the fair. Any diseased animal will be removed from the grounds. Fair veterinarian recommendations will be followed.
9. Stall, pens and alleys must be kept clean and clear for the convenience of spectators.
10. Exhibitors must furnish all water pails and feed pans.
11. Any animal deemed by the Livestock Committee as unsafe will not be allowed to show.
12. The Superintendent reserves the right to refuse entry of stock for competition that is not in his/her judgment in suitable show condition.
13. General Rules and Regulations govern, but Special Rules of each division take precedence over all other rules except New Mexico Livestock Board Rules.

14. The following livestock exhibitors must provide proof of a (negative) Tuberculosis test within 30 days prior to the date of fair.
* Dairy Cattle * Dairy Goats * Beef Cattle
15. The following livestock must provide proof of a (negative) Brucellosis (bangs) test within 30 days prior to the date of the fair:
* Dairy cattle * Dairy Goats * Beef Heifers & Cows

16. Junior exhibitors & representatives will be permitted on the grounds until 10:00 p.m.
17. Anyone who desires to file a complaint, see General Rules # 9 to do so.
18. National Show Ring Rules of Ethics will be followed.
19. Pee Wee shows will include Market Goats, Market Lambs, and Market Swine. Pee Wee livestock shows will follow the junior livestock showmanship class of their respective species. Pee Wee exhibitors may tag and raise their own animal(s) or may show a borrowed animal owned and exhibited by a junior exhibitor. It is the participant's responsibility to make arrangement to borrow livestock. All animals must be tagged and must be compliant with New Mexico Livestock Board of Health Rules. Pee Wee show is a participation show only. Animals will not be placed. Awards will be given to all participants. Pee Wee participants must be 5 years old by the date of Livestock Check-in for the current year and must be under the required age of a 4-H Novice. Entry forms and fees must be post marked by July 16, 2018.
20. Gate admission passes are available for junior livestock exhibitors via the livestock entry forms for Friday, August 10th and Saturday, August 11th. Passes for livestock exhibitors are free. Passes for immediate family (parents/legal guardians and siblings) are available for \$2.00 and must be purchased at time of livestock entry. These passes will not be sold during the fair. Each pass will admit one for both Friday and Saturday from 6:00am – 6:00pm. Children 3 and under are free. There are no admission fees for Monday, August 6th – Thursday August 9th or Sunday, August 12th. Passes do NOT allow admittance to the County Fair Dances.
