Special Rules

1. Decorative wood is considered dried material and is not permitted in fresh flower classes.
2. Naturally shed flowers, feathers, etc., from non-endangered species may be used.
3. Accessories are permitted in all arrangements.
4. Plant material need not be grown by the exhibitor.
5. No artificial plant material is permitted.
