1. ALL New Mexico Livestock Board rules apply regarding Certificates of Veterinary Inspection, Tuberculosis, and Brucellosis. Please see New Mexico Livestock Board rules to ensure full compliance.
2. The Breeding Class is a "Blow and Show". NO artificial coloring, glues, or adhesives will be allowed, no exceptions while on the Valencia County Fairgrounds. There will be no clipping allowed on show day.
3. Sale slots to be determined based on number of entries and as placed in the Grand Drive. Only animals in the Grand Drive are eligible for sale.
4. Classes J-10 and J-11 should be bred heifers. Exhibitors should provide proof of breeding or heifer should have unweaned calf at her side.
5. Exhibitors are responsible for keeping pens neat and aisles clear at all times. Cattle are to be maintained by the exhibitor throughout the Show, making sure they are well kept, well groomed, and in show condition. Public aisles and walkways must be kept clear of tack, chairs, equipment and animals.
6. Cattle with sickness or abnormalities. The Livestock Committee reserves the right to reject cattle showing signs of sickness, lice, ringworm, (or other skin conditions including those commonly known as "fungus") abscesses, ulcerations, abnormality or uncontrollable temperament. The Committee's decision is final and entry fees will not be refunded. The exhibitor must remove a rejected animal from the grounds immediately upon decision of the Committee.
