
RULE CHANGES FOR 2022

1. Online Livestock Entries due July 1, 2022. Late Entries must be postmarked by August 1, 2022.
2. Production Heifer Class (slick shear class) Heifers/Cows 15 months of age and older must provide proof of being bred or have an unweaned calf at their side.
3. Production Steer top weight will be 1,400 lbs, with a hot carcass top weight of 950 lbs.
4. Top pay weight for packer price on market steers will be 1,400 lbs.
5. Rule 3 in Junior Market Steers has been removed. It was the Steer show is "Blow and Show". NO artificial coloring, glues, or adhesives will be allowed, no exceptions while on the Valencia County Fairgrounds. There will be no clipping allowed on show day.
6. Rule 2 in Breeding Heifer has been removed. It was the Breeding Class is a "Blow and Show". NO artificial coloring, glues, or adhesives will be allowed, no exceptions while on the Valencia County Fairgrounds. There will be no clipping allowed on show day.
7. Market Sheep, Breeding Ewes, Market Goats and Breeding Does must be stripped of all blankets, coverings and wraps before they enter the ring for classification and weigh in.
8. Sale slots for the Production Heifer class will be determined based on the number of entries and as placed in the Grand Drive. Only animals in the Grand Drive are eligible for sale.
9. Rule 4 in Meat Goats has been removed. It was all meat goats will be groomed for show with not more than 3/8 inch of hair over the hock.
10. There will be NO electricity furnished by the Valencia County Fair, you must bring your own generators.
